



NORTH ANDROS ISLAND, BAHAMAS



The Property

Lured Inn Bahamas is situated on an acre and a half of untouched, ocean front property, featuring two newer homes built in 2020/21, The Beach House and The Bungalow. Both homes are coastal inspired with an open and airy floor plan with lots of windows allowing for natural light and an ocean breeze. To communicate a relaxing feel, lighter tones in shades of blue, green, beige, and white are emphasized throughout the homes, with a splash of color for added personality.

While the décor and furnishings are simple in style, color, and material, they provide the natural beauty of the exterior surroundings.

Just steps out your door, the water is clear, calm, and shallow, and the beaches are soft, white, and clean. As mentioned before, this is not only ideal for Bone Fishing, but also safe for the little ones who want to build sandcastles, splash around in the bay and see an occasional sea turtle.

The kitchens have gorgeous granite countertops and new stainless-steel appliances to include refrigerator, glass-top stove, microwave, and dishwasher and are fully equipped with everything you will need to prepare a gourmet meal or simply grilling fish on the barbeque.

The beautifully crafted, high-quality stoneware is embossed in nautical accents and has an antique finish. Each setting is accompanied by matching silverware, glasses, napkins, and coastal-themed silver napkin rings. The setting compliments both formal and casual occasions.



Getting Here

> DIRECT FROM FORT LAUDERDALE

AZTEC AIR, MAKERS AIR AND WESTERN AIR fly direct to North Andros Island (SAQ) Visit the website for flight schedule and luggage policy.

> FROM NASSAU

Book a flight directly into Nassau, landing in Nassau before 3:30pm.

From Nassau, I will arrange for our pilot to fly your party to the Island. (The law prohibits flying after dark, so he will only be able to fly your party to the island if you arrive in Nassau in the daylight.)

The plane can accommodate 5 passengers and the cost (for a one-way trip) to SAQ (North Andros Airport) is currently \$600, which is divided equally among the passengers; he attempts to fill the plane, so each person is only responsible for \$120.

If your party has more than five passengers, he has access to either a larger plane or I can arrange a second plane to accommodate your party.

Upon landing in Andros, our driver, James, aka "Killer" will bring you to the property; a 15-minute drive. Currently, the cost is \$50/couple and an additional \$5/person. Upon request, he will stop by the grocery store and a "small" liquor store should you need anything (an additional tip for this service is appreciated.)

Path of Least Resistance...

After landing in Nassau, go down the escalator to baggage claim.

For \$20, pay the baggage handler to wheel your luggage through security, and outside to the taxi coordinator; request a ride to "GENERAL AVIATION".

This 5-minute taxi ride will cost \$30-\$35.

Our pilot, Big-O, will be waiting to fly you to the island. He likes cash, but accepts Venmo, Zelle and Credit Card.

o The luggage handler will take your bags off the plane and wheel them to the front of the building (we usually tip him \$5-\$7), where our driver will be waiting to drive you to the property.

The Lodge



The Lodge is the larger of the two, closer to the water. This 2000sq.ft. home has 3 oversized bedrooms, each with a private, in-suite full bathroom. There is also an outdoor shower located on the side of the house, an excellent place to wash off the salt and the sand. The rooms are furnished with one king bed, that can be converted into 2 Twin XL Beds, sleeping a total of 6 guests. (Air mattresses provided upon request for additional sleeping arrangements.) The master suite features French doors leading onto a private ocean front porch. The dining room shares the open space of the kitchen, breakfast bar, sitting room, and sunken living room, making for a great area to gather. The floor to ceiling glass doors allows for a panoramic view of your private seascape; the only thing better than this backdrop, is to open these doors to the deck, where the tropical aroma and the light sea breeze will fill your senses and sweep you off your feet into another world where you can unwind and relax.

Navigating the Island

Rental: You may want to consider renting a car for touring the Island, as North Andros is the largest of the Bahamian Islands and there is a lot to explore and discover.

Vehicles can be rented from the SAQ airport and rented privately. Since there are limited car rental services on the island, we recommend making arrangements in advance. Expect to pay \$75 - \$100 dollars per day, depending on the size of vehicle you want and need. There is only one road, and no traffic, so driving anywhere is fast and easy, but remember to drive on the LEFT side of the road. The cost of fuel is around \$6.75 per gallon and bring cash for gas.

Taxi: Should you need a ride to/from the airport, taxi service is available. The fee is \$50.00/ride per couple, and an additional \$5.00 extra per passenger from the Airport to Lured Inn. For an additional fee, driver will take you to grocery/liquor store on your way out to Lured Inn.

What to Bring



- Swimsuit
- Casual Attire

- Baby Oil/Bug Spray (Deterrents for 'No-see-ums'; those invisible biting gnats that come out in the morning and evening, and biting "Doctor Flies".)
- Personal fishing and snorkeling gear (if you prefer to use your own equipment)
- Camara
- Cash – Not many businesses or restaurants take credit cards, and you will need cash for excursions, fishing, taxi and tips.
- Alcohol: While the spirits, wine and beer selection is surprisingly good, if you want something special, each traveler is allowed to bring 3 bottles of spirits and 3 bottles of wine into the country.
- Specialty coffee, bagels, cheese, meat, snacks, and food (gluten free, sugar free, etc.)
- Meat and cheese must be frozen or semi-frozen.
- Check with your airline regarding their luggage policy.

Bone Fishing

North Andros Island is the Bone Fishing capital of the world! We can arrange for one of our captains to pick you up directly in front of the property to take you out. The cost is \$650-\$750/day per boat, for two anglers (tip is not included.) You will fish from 8am until you are ready to stop for the day. If you do not have personal fishing gear, we will provide poles.

Restaurant/Bars

The island has several little local “dive bars and restaurants.” Do not expect Ruth Chris, as you may be overdressed if you are wearing a tee shirt and cut-off shorts. LOL!

Call in advance to ensure they are open and serving... as the days and hours of operation may vary greatly. Some places may only be open the 3rd Thursday of the month from 3 -5pm...and ONLY on a full moon! Hahaha!!!

The bars and restaurants are anywhere from 1 to 25 miles from our house, depending on which settlement they are in (Lowe Sound, Mastic Point, Fresh Creek, Nichols Town).

The Bahamian Cuisine consists of Rice, Beans, Conch Fritters, Fried Conch and Conch Salad and seasonal fish; however, there are a few places that serve a great Cheeseburger, Pulled Pork, and Pizza!



Shopping on the Island

Shopping is limited, however, there are a few small shops within 1–25 miles of our property that carry souvenirs, clothing, shoes, sunglasses, pharmaceuticals, etc.

Although the shops may look like an abandoned home, they all have different things to offer and an interesting collection of items.





Grocery/Liquor Stores

The Island only has a handful of “neighborhood markets” and liquor stores and all are located within 10 to 20 minutes of the property. The food selection is adequate, can be limited, so the options are to either make-do with what the stores offer, or pack and additional suitcase or cooler with specific food you wish to eat. If you want quality meat, cheese, and coffee, I recommend bringing it with you. The Bahamas permits you to either “check” or “carry-on” meat and cheese only if the MEAT is frozen. If you want a specific alcohol, each person is allowed to bring onto the island three bottles of wine and three bottles of spirits; however, there are a few liquor stores that have a surprisingly good selection of both. Because food and liquor are imported, expect to pay higher prices.



Medical

The Island has a small medical clinic located in Nichols Town (3.5 miles from the property). The pharmacy is located on Queens Highway, approximately 7 miles from the property. For a medical emergency, contact our pilot, Big-O to fly you to Nassau, or preferably, Fort Lauderdale or Miami.

Cash, Credit Card and Currency

- Bring CASH for guided fishing, dining, tips, shopping, etc.
- You must declare the cash amount you have on hand if over \$10,000
- The grocery store and liquor store accept credit cards; however, the fee is 10%-15%.
- Several merchants do not accept credit cards and often, the credit card machine is “out of order.”
- There is only one ATM machine on the island, and again, the charge is 10% - 15% per transaction; furthermore, the machine frequently “has no cash”.
- US Dollars are 1 to 1 with the Bahamian Dollar and are exchanged equally. There is no need to convert money into the Bahamian currency.
- Since all items are imported onto the island, expect to pay more. The value



Cell Service, Wi-Fi, and Communication

- Download “WHATSAPP” onto your cell phone. This is the number one means of communication on the island (and most countries for that matter).
- It is serviced through Wi-Fi, so you are not charged.
- It is a fantastic way to take pictures and videos, which are automatically downloaded onto your phone and a hundred can be sent at a time w/out the “file too large” message.
- The property has high speed internet.

The Beach and Equipment

- Our beach-front property is extremely Private, Quiet and Clean! On a crowded day, you may see one other couple (renting the property down the beach) walking along the shore. Other than that, the beach and the sand are all yours!
- Our caretaker may be on site early in the morning (as needed), to clean seaweed that may have washed up, rake the sand and remove trash. He respects our privacy and stays out of sight when we have guests.
- The white sand and turquoise water are a stones-throw from our back door. You can walk miles on the shoreline and will not see a soul!
- Fishing, snorkeling, and LOBSTER hunting may be arranged with a professional guide, or self-guided directly in front of the house.
- Kayaks, tubes, spears, fishing gear, snorkels, paddleboards, and a volleyball net are available for our guests to enjoy.



Water Temperature & Depth

- The water temperature ranges from 75 degrees Fahrenheit to 87 degrees Fahrenheit depending on the time of year.
- The property is in Pleasant Harbor Bay, protected by the third largest barrier reef in the world and surrounded by tropical plants and trees.
- We are located on a stretch of ocean water known as the "Flats." This is an area of shallow water, with a relatively even bottom. The water level can range from a few inches to a few feet and goes on for miles and miles.
- Because Bone fish reside in the flats, Bone fishing is exceptionally great!
